This event represents the most ambitious undertaking in TAP-Chicago's history, and we are glad you are a part of it!

Our annual lunar New Year celebration has always been a favorite for members. This year, we are excited to host three times the number of attendees and provide a higher level of food, beverage, atmosphere, and entertainment. Additionally, we are proud to bring you 4 different Asian American cultural performances representing both traditional and contemporary styles. We are grateful for the support of almost 40 major sponsors and organization partners.

This year has been filled with growth for TAP-Chicago as we continued our transformation from a casual social network to a more effective and focused community organization. Thanks to the efforts of the dozens of volunteers that make up our Leadership Board, Advisory Board, committees, and event production teams, in the last year we have:

- More than doubled membership to over 1,000 people
- Increased event frequency to 5 per month (approx 60 per year)

- Expanded our core organizing group from 5 or 6 members to 19 Leadership Board members
- Collaborated with over a dozen other community groups
- Hosted events at some of the city's best venues like Grid, Pump Room, Hubbard Inn, Benchmark, JW Marriott, and Union Sushi

While we faced our share of challenges this year, I have been constantly surprised and inspired by the dedication and enthusiasm of our team. We discovered the difficulty of effectively coordinating and motivating a large, all-volunteer, part-time, virtual team. And along the way we learned that we value:

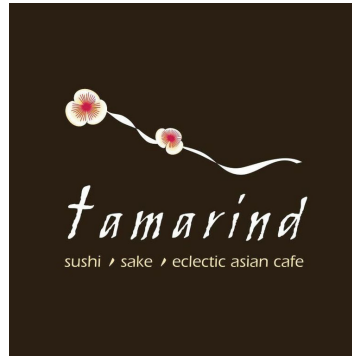

# Performance Biographies

## Chicago Chinese Cultural Center Lion Dance Troupe

The Chicago Chinese Cultural Center lion dance team, directed by P.C. Leung, was founded in 1990 with a mission to promote Chinese culture, health and physical fitness. The team is one of the most prominent lion dance groups in the Chicagoland area and has performed at many venues including Millennium Park, McCormick Place, Peninsula Hotel, Navy Pier, Field Museum, Adler Planetarium, Shedd Aquarium, Museum of Science and Industry, Art Institute, Garfield Park, O'Hare Airport, United Center, Soldier Field, and Brookfield Zoo.



The lion dance tradition dates back thousands of years. The dance brings prosperity, luck and happiness. The origin of the Lion Dance at Chinese New Year is thought to have started through a legend handed down through the generations. According to the legend a mythical beast called a Nian (meaning year in Chinese) would come and attack villagers at the same time every year. The villagers asked for the help of a great colorful lion spirit, who came and drove the Nian away with much noise. The following year the people were left defenseless as the lion was away defending the Emperor's Palace. The people improvised and created a false lion out of cloth and bamboo along with noisy firecrackers to drive the Nian away. This was so successful that every year since then the lion dance is performed to frighten away evil spirits and bring luck in with the New Year.



## Flying Fairies Dance Group

Founded in 2010, the Flying Fairies Dance Arts Center is a performing arts and educational organization that promotes the understanding and appreciation of Chinese culture by preserving traditional genres and nurturing innovations that reflect our dynamic and diverse cultural heritage. The dance group is led by Ms. Jin Qiu Yue, one of Chicago's foremost Chinese dancers, choreographers and educators. The group is composed of children and adults from the Chicagoland area who are enthusiasts of traditional Chinese dance. Its mission is to share the richness of Chinese heritage and culture through the professional training and performance of traditional, classical and folk dances. Our performers have participated in numerous festivals and celebrations throughout Chicagoland, including the spectacular Qi Xi production at Millennium Park attended by over 6,000 people.





### Ho Etsu Taiko

Ho Etsu Taiko is a Chicago-based Japanese music ensemble that brings a passionate energy and lively spirit to taiko's rich tradition. We offer a bright and lively sound, infusing taiko's cultural legacy with new vitality and bridging the tradition through fresh experiences and influences. 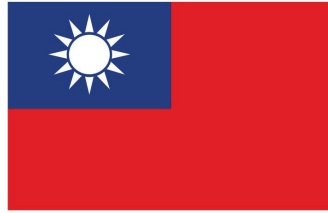

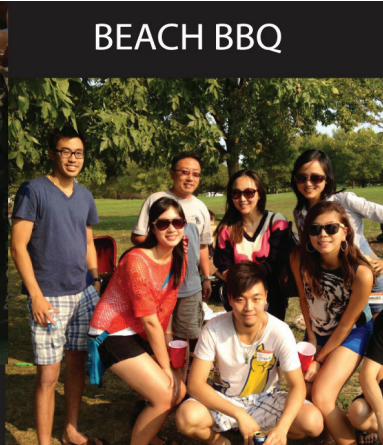
